Part 1 – Individual presentation (2 minutes)

You will be asked to give a presentation on a topic related to the following:

- Sharing an experience (e.g. about an argument you had with the others)
- b. Responding to a situation (e.g. giving advice to someone)
- Giving suggestions of activities to achieve a purpose c.

The presentation should last for about 2 minutes. You will be given a score sheet and a note card in the preparation room. Then you will have 4 minutes to write your notes (in point form) on your note card. You should not read directly from your own notes in order to make eye contact with the examiner.

After the assessment, the note card and the score sheet will be collected. Feedback may also be given.

Part 2 – Reading aloud (1 minute)

Students can practice reading these texts.
