Topic 1	<i>Your teacher has asked you to talk about how you have dinner in Hong Kong.</i> What food would you eat for your dinner in Hong Kong? Where would you go to eat? Who would you eat your dinner with?				
Topic 2	<i>Your teacher has asked you to talk about how you celebrate Christmas.</i> What kind of things do you do, before Christmas, on the night before Christmas, and on Christmas day? Who do you spend your time with? What kinds of presents do you like?				
Topic 3	<i>You and two other classmates are discussing life as a teenager.</i> What are some of the changes that you experience as a teenager? What are the pressures you have when you are a teenager? Who can you talk to when you need some help and advice?				
Topic 4	<i>You are talking to your friend about life at school.</i> What lessons do you have? Do you have a favourite subject? What are your teachers like? What do you do with your friends? What activities do you enjoy?				

Remember to start your presentation like this:

Good morning / Good afternoon! Today I want to talk about ...
