1. prosecute (v) - to officially accuse someone of committing a crime in a law court
2. alleged (adj) – said to be bad or illegal without proof yet
3. condemn (v) – criticize sth/sb strongly for moral reasons
4. prompt (v) – to make something happen, cause
5. prosecutor (n) – a legal official who accuses sb of a crime
6. accuse (sb) of – say that someone has done something morally wrong, illegal or unkind
7. acquit (v) – decide officially in a law court that sb is not guilty
8. testimony (n) – statements that something is true
